

NRL Coaching Coordinator



The NRL Coaching Coordinator position is responsible for the management of allocated club's coaching program, behaviors and performance, promoting the value of coaching within the Junior League district allocated clubs.

Responsible To

The NRL Coaching Coordinator is directly responsible to NRL Regional Game Development Manager or NRL Game Development Officer.

Responsibilities and Duties

Achieve 100% accreditation compliance and an appropriate coaching philosophy within allocated Junior Rugby League Clubs.

- » In conjunction with the NRL, League and District, ensure all club coaches hold appropriate qualifications
- » Provide all relevant information to club secretaries to ensure records of club coaches and coaching qualifications are maintained
- » Attend nominated games to assess coaching performance
- » Foster positive spirit amongst all coaches and encourage them to participate in a sporting manner
- » Enhance feelings of self-confidence and self-esteem within the coaches
- » Meet regularly with coaches to discuss performance and provide feedback
- » Encourage maximum participation from the coaches
- » Liaise with other allocated club representatives regularly
- » Constantly highlight the importance of the NRL National Code of Conduct and NRL Safe Play Code
- » Continually seek out potential coaches and recruit whenever possible
- » Coordinate necessary accreditation opportunities

Knowledge and Skills Required

Ideally the NRL Coaching Coordinator is someone who:

- » Has leadership skills
- » Has good motivational and communication skills
- » Is able to evaluate coach performance and provide positive advice
- » Maintains or improves his/her current accreditation level
- » Have sound understanding of modern coaching and teaching principles
- » Can communicate effectively and has good interpersonal skills
- » Have a sound understanding of the NRL's, League and Districts rules and regulations
- » Has good time management, punctuality and organization

Commitment Required

Provide a monthly report on activities to the NRL Coach Education Coordinator and/or NRL Coach Mentor

Coach Coordinators
