

JUNIOR ROOSTERS JOB DESCRIPTION

Assistant Coach

- Reports to the Wellbeing, Education and Junior Pathways Manager
- Performs duties in consultation with the Coach
- Conduct all sessions based on sound coaching principles
- Adhere to Coach's Code of Conduct
- Ensure players develop an acceptable Code of Conduct both on and off the field
- Attend all games and squad training sessions
- Attend junior league matches in the appropriate age groups
- Liaise with junior league coaches in the appropriate groups age
- Assist with squad selection
- Monitor progress of squad members at junior club games
- Maintain player attendance records for all activities

Game Day

- Monitor correct use of interchange system
- Analyse and appraise team and individual performance
- Provide feedback to the coach relating to individual player performance
- In consultation with the coach, compile team awards
- Distribute and collect playing attire
- Ensure the team is correctly outfitted
- Ensure appropriate quantities of water, ice and plastic cups are available in the dressing room

Post-Match

- Check team injuries, provide guidance to injured players and ensure correct medical procedures are followed
- Communicate team awards to the Wellbeing, Education and Junior Pathways Manager
- In conjunction with the coach, submit a brief team performance report to the Junior **Program Manager**
- Assist the team manager with the recount and bagging of playing gear for logistics
- Final check of dressing room, all gear and valuables collected and room left in a tidy and hygienic condition
- Make sure the changing room is left in a clean state assist Gear Steward with the breakdown and packing away of any equipment.
